Santa Rosa is a small city located in the southern area of Guatemala about 75 kilometers away from the country's capital and approximately 1,000 to 1,300 meters above sea level. The region it is located in is often referred to as the "Volcanic Highlands" and maintains an average temperature of 23 degrees Celsius. The coffee grown in this region provides a very balanced cup with heavy chocolate notes. The harvest months are December to March.

CUPPING NOTES: Dark Chocolate, Hazelnut, Malty, Slightly Earthy and Citrus, with a Medium Body and Acidity.
