During the process, the coffee beans are soaked in hot water where the caffeine is extracted and the MC is added to the mixture to bind to the caffeine. it draws 99% of the caffeine from the beans while leaving behind the beans' flavor oils. Our MC decaffeinated Brazilian coffee is bold and flavorful.
