Papua New Guinea, a nation of 600+ islands and 715 indigenous languages, occupies the eastern half of the South Pacific island of New Guinea, the world's second largest island. There are 16 producing provinces across Papua New Guinea, with 90% of production in the Eastern Highlands, Western Highlands, Jiwaka, Morobe, and Simbu provinces. The vast majority of the coffee is exported, providing an income to 400,000 rural households.
