The story of Java began in 1696 when the mayor of Amsterdam, Nicholas Witsen, ordered the Dutch commander of the Malabar Coast, Adrian van Ommen, to take the seeds of *Coffea Arabica* from the Malabar Coast in India and grow them in Java, Indonesia. In 1699, Henricus Zwaardecroon planted seeds in Java, especially in Bandung area. Botanists in Amsterdam concluded that these were high quality seeds and were planted in the gardens of elite nobility including King of France Louis XIV. Large-scale plantations thrived by began in 1707. In 19th Century "Java Preanger" was so popular in Europe that coffee became known as "a cup of Java," the best coffee in the world at the time. Java Preanger is still known as one of the most iconic coffee beans.
