

ORGANIC PAPUA NEW GUINEA

PRODUCERS: Over 2,000 Small Holder Farmers

REGION: Morobe Province

ALTITUDE: 600 – 1,800 M

PROCESSING: Washed and Sun Dried

VARIETAL: Typica, Bourbon

HARVEST MONTHS: April to September

Papua New Guinea, a nation of 600+ islands and 715 indigenous languages, occupies the eastern half of the South Pacific island of New Guinea, the world's second largest island. There are 16 producing provinces across Papua New Guinea, with 90% of production in the Eastern Highlands, Western Highlands, Jiwaka, Morobe, and Chimbu provinces. The vast majority of the coffee is exported, providing an income to 400,000 rural households. These farmers are well supported by 2 dry processing facilities: one in Wau and the other in Lae the Industrial and Export hub of Papua New Guinea.

CUPPING NOTES: Medium Acidity, Soft Body, Black Currant, Red Wine, Dried Fruit.



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
