CERRO AZUL

REGION: Comayagua

ALTITUDE: 1,300 to 1,600 M

PRODUCER: COHORSIL

VARIETAL: Caturra, Catuai, Typica, Pacas

Cerro Azul is produced on various smallholder farms in the COHORSIL COOP, which is located in the lush valley that borders the town of Siguatepeque, in the Montecillos mountain range, in the central Honduran highland department of Comayagua. The COOP provides loans, sustainability training, technical support and agricultural services to its members.

Cerro Azul is a mix of the 4 varieties commonly found across Honduras: Caturra, Catuai, Typica and Pacas. The producers bring their harvest down from their farms to one of Cohorsil's central wet mills where they can have their cherries processed. The wet mills are equipped with large drying patios and drying tunnels to be able to process all local associates' coffee.

CUPPING NOTES: Medium Acidity and Body, Brown Butter, Vanilla, Green Apple, Brown Sugar.



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
